##### CoBrA in retrospective

In 1948 artists from Denmark, Belgium and Holland formed an artistic avant-garde movement – the agenda of the movement entitled CoBrA, was to create art with a complete freedom of colour and form. The style from this movement, that was active from 1949 – 1952, is both colourful, playful and often has a surrealist twist.

As a tribute to the movement and the artistic style there has been arranged an extensive exhibition, where the work of the most prominent and trendsetting CoBrA artists

can be experienced. Therefore the work of the Danish CoBrA

artists Asger Jorn, Carl-Henning Pedersen and Henry Heerup will also be represented at the exhibition.
