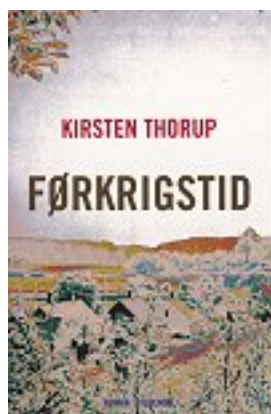


GUK on DK Tour
